### Action Taken Report on Feedback

For employers, internships provide an opportunity to evaluate potential employees before making a long-term commitment. 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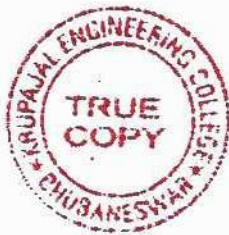
