No. SDTE-HTE-HTE-I-0010-2017/ 7664 /SDTE, In exercise of power conferred on Government under sub-section-7 of Section- 6 and other provisions of the Odisha Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission & Fixation of Fee) Act, 2007 and basing on the recommendation of the Fee Structure Committee in its 14<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 10.10.2025, Government have been pleased to revise the fee structure of the following Professional/ Technical Colleges as detailed below to be implemented w.e.f. academic session 2025-26.

Sl No.	Name of the Institute	Decisions taken in this FSC meeting
1	Krupajal Engineering College, Bhubaneswar	Rs. 38,500/- (33,500/- + 5,000/- for NAAC A+) for B.Tech Course Rs. 44,000/- (39,000/- + 5,000/- for NAAC A+) for M.Tech Course Rs. 38,500/- (33,500/- + 5,000/- for NAAC A+) for MCA Course
2	Rajdhani College of Engineering & Management, Bhubaneswar	FSC decided to enhance the fee already determined w.e.f AY 2025-26 to 2027-28, by Rs. 4,000/- on account of NAAC B+ Grade status in the following manner: Rs. 61,000/- (57,000/- + 4,000/-) for MBA Course Rs. 36,500/- (32,500/- + 4,000/-) for first 3 years of IMBA Course. Rs. 61,000/- (57,000/- + 4,000/-) for last 2 years of IMBA Course.
3	Ganesh Institute of Engineering & Technology, Bhubaneswar	Fee structure is determined at Rs. 42,000/- (38,000/- + 4,000/-) for three branches only i.e., Civil Engg., Electrical Engg. and Mechanical Engg. from AY 2025-26 to 2027-28.
